The participants will be involved in different projects and activities conducted by the GIWEH. The course develops necessary skills and competences through collaborative work between professionals, experts and researchers.

The program welcomes students of undergraduate, graduate or postgraduate levels in environmental, political, social and/or economic disciplines and provides them with an opportunity to deepen their knowledge of water and environmental issues. The participants will benefit from multidisciplinary approach adapted by the GIWEH and its international team. They will have a full access to the United Nations library, University of Geneva; moreover, GIWEH can facilitate communication with private sector and non-governmental organizations.

OBJECTIVES

The main objectives of this training program are:

- to give participants practical experience on ground,
- to teach them new concepts of water and environmental governance, as well as its institutional and legal frameworks.
- To provide them a platform for open discussions with the United Nations professionals and provides with a knowledge of technologies and its transfer.

TARGET GROUP

Interested students and professionals with environmental, political, social and/or economic background, civil society and youth leaders. Maximum Number of participants in each module is 30.

- **Week I (Introductory Week)** Presentation and discussion of country specific cases that participants would have to prepare in advance
- Week II Lectures and visits to universities located in Geneva
- **Week III** Visiting United Nations organizations and private sector and Group work analysis and field trip
- Week IV Submission and presentation of a paper on a chosen topic
